### What is the Civil Industry?

Civil Engineering is a branch involved with the maintenance, design, and construction of both natural and physically built environments such as roads, railways, buildings, water reservoirs, subdivisions, airports, bridges, sewer systems, tunnels, and dams.

Civil Train SA is offering an in-house 3-hour interactive Industry Immersion Session.

Students will have the opportunity to gain an interactive experience in the world of Civil Construction through; gamified learning; and operate a variety of simulated heavy machinery, including:

- Excavators
- Frontend loaders
- Haul trucks

Students will learn how to undertake pre-starts and how to safely operate the vehicles.
