"We learnt about leadership in sport and how to make games up for younger kids. We are looking forward to starting a dance club. I am looking forward to planning it" - Sharlee

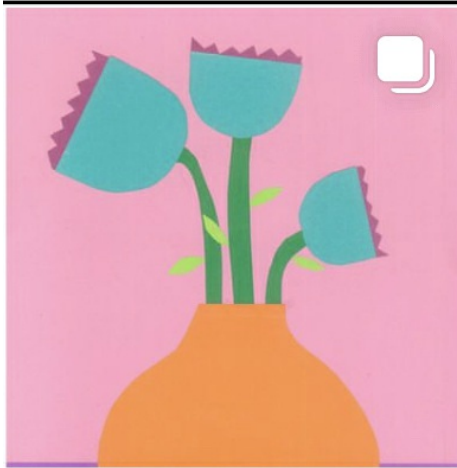
"We talked about teamwork, communication and how to talk to the kids to organise them and get their attention" - Lilah
