We are pleased to introduce the students who will be serving in significant Middle Years student leadership roles for 2024.

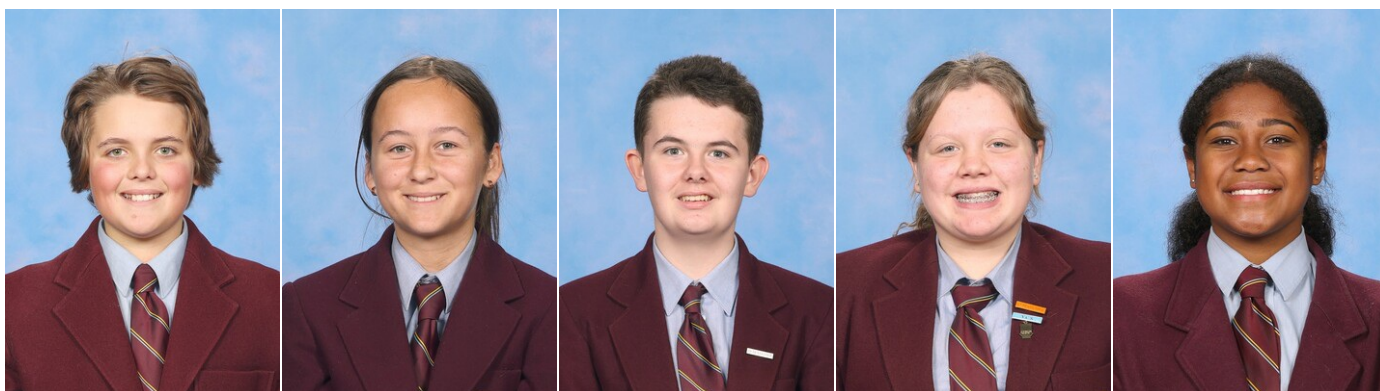

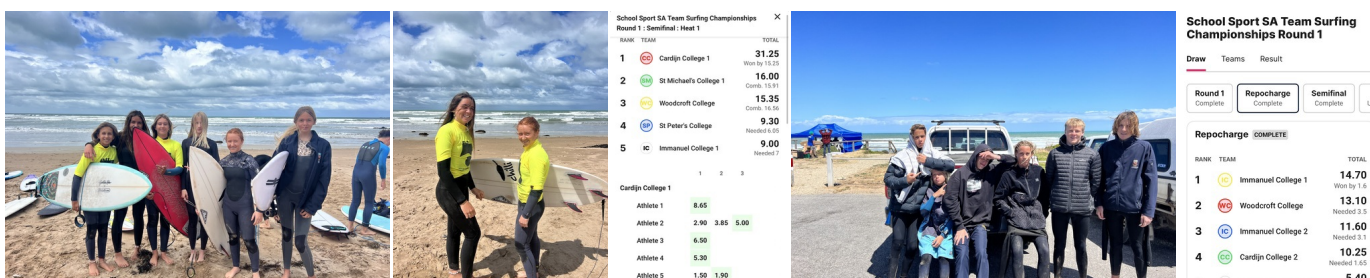
## Marian Campus Surfers Shine at Middleton Beach Tag Team Event
