


Year 4 Camp




MEGT Women in Non-Traditional Trades

I recently had the privilege of attending a conference for the Deputy Principals of Marist Schools across Australia at 'The Hermitage' in Mittagong. The Hermitage is located in the Southern Highlands of New South Wales and is the spiritual home of the Marist Brothers in Australia.
